INTRODUCTION

The meeting called “Meeting of Izmir’s Initiative on Youth” was held by the directorate of Youth Work and Social Project belonging to Izmir Metropolitan Municipality, in block A of Historical Gas Factory, “Fikrim-İz”.

To discuss about youth strategies, youth policies and European Youth Capital application process, 58 participants including representatives from 28 non-governmental organizations and 10 local municipalities gathered above the title of “Urban and Youth”

THE AIM OF THE MEETING

Izmir Metropolitan Municipality has been running youth works with prioritizing the participatory way of governing and common mind. “2026 European Youth Capital[1]” application process has been begun and the strategy and methodology were determined to run the process and then to gain the title with youngsters' participation.

The sensitive point for Izmir Metropolitan Municipality is to reshape public sphere in cooperation with the young people and youth workers. In this respect, the process of determining youth strategies, participation of youth on decision-making and producing youth policies is held by Izmir Metropolitan Municipality which appropriates the vision of “Youth-friendly City”.

The main goal of the meeting is to determine actual problems that are experienced by young people themselves and producing solutions to these problems with arguing about them. This methodology leads the institutions work with the idea of participations. At the end of the meeting, with consideration of suggested solutions toward determined problems, a working team is supposed to be determined and this team will run the “2026 European Youth Capital” through the year.

[1] European Youth Capital; It has been given title to a country by European Youth Forum since 2009. The selected city could find an opportunity to present its development plan on youth including cultural, economical, social and political issues.

THE TARGET OF THE MEETING

The target of the meeting is to run youth works with the idea of participation and common mind. To accomplish the target, there are needed works within “2026 European Youth Capital” application.

As goals of the meeting, providing proper communication between actors, analysing the current situation of youth and the city and producing solutions through the analyses, strengthening cooperations and creating a working team consisted of young representatives to run the process of “2026 European Youth Capital” candidacy, could be listed.

METHODOLOGY AND CONTENT

At the beginning of the meeting, the moderator made a presentation about informations of the main goal, targets and the process, youth agenda and youth strategy, and youth policies in local and national sense. The speechers were M. Anıl Kaçar (the Head of Social Project Department), I. Ferhat Kaplan (the Head of Youth Council by Izmir City Council), Can Ercebe (Youth Worker), and H. Oğuzhan Aytaç (the General Manager of GoFor) respectively.

OPENING SPEECHES

Mehmet Anıl Kaçar

(Izmir Metropolitan Municipality; the Head of Social Project Department)

After the transmission of informations about the fields that Izmir Metropolitan Municipality is responsible to, the participants accepted a thank for their attendance. Participants were infomed about the general functions and structure of managing the process of "2025 European Youth Capital" candidacy,

During the speech, the importance of togetherness and participation was mentioned and completing the process together was determined as a goal.

Lastly, the essentialness of fabricating linguistic creation of youth policy with the assistance of different stakeholders and expanding the youth works throughout the country, was one of the issue of meeting topics. After informing people on "2025 European Youth Capital" candidacy, he elucidated participants about "2026 European Youth Capital" with using of Izmir Youth Municipality as an example.

OPENING SPEECHES

İsmail Ferhat Kaplan **(Izmir City Council; the Head of Youth Council)**

Through the year when “2026 European Youth Capital” candidacy will be run, with rising up range of responsibilities of the council, they accepted the facilitator role. They declared their active existence with other related institutions and organizations in terms of cooperation.

Can Ercebe **(Youth Worker)**

After indicating the fields that the applicant are responsible to during the process of European Youth Capital candidacy, the institutional ideas on youth works on local and national senses was shared. The lack of youth policy and its effects were the topic that was mentioned.

Short notes that were derived from the presentation;

- The current situation of youth and Turkey: Lack of official document on youth rights that build upon the idea of participation and other values, was one of the issues. The young people who were the actual actors of this event, has lots of things to lose. Therefore, I want to name this event as “The meeting of people who has lots of things to lose”.
- The youth prioritized point of view was argued again. In addition, the public sphere, common mind, living together and re-shaping ideas should be done by leadership of youth; there was a consensus created on this statement.
- The importance of European Youth Capital is, besides its effectiveness on solving some problems on local sense, very valuable to increase protection of youth rights and youth existence on decision-making.
- What is the European Youth Capital title? What will happen with application of this title?

Hasan Oğuzhan Aytaç **(The General Manager of GoFor)**

Mr. Aytaç gave informations about Go-For, European Youth Forum and European Youth Capital title. He talked about Go-For which is a kind of non-governmental organizations gathering institutions to make them more active in decision-making processes and on public sphere. The institution aims to introduce right-based youth policies to NGOs and public sector as well; thereby effects of youth work is increased.

OPENING SPEECHES

- Go-For;

Which is running right based youth works tries to increase public awareness to escalate adapting youth rights on European values more, rise capacity of student groups, gather all youth workers in a network and protection youth rights.

- European Youth Forum

European Youth Forum's main goal is to organize youth workers and youth based organizations to represent youth in a common interest. It consists of international NGOs which is more than 100 national youth councils and youth organizations. European Youth Forum tries to make young people participate actively to shape the society and make their life conditions better.

- European Youth Capital

European Youth Capital is a title that might be one of apparatuses for "mainstreaming of youth participation". Although NGOs in Turkey care about the European values, the conjuncture push them aside from the European community. If any of cities in Turkey can get the title, it makes adaptation of youth rights to European values easier. The outcome of Izmir's success on listing as final cities on 2025 European Youth Capital is creation of this cycle (the meeting derived from previous co-working), and making it sustainable and eternal is one of the goals of them.

OPENING SPEECHES

Can Ercebe (Youth Worker)

After Hasan Oğuzhan Aytaç's speech, Can Ercebe continued his presentation toward the titles; technical components, organic components and the targets of the meeting.

- Technical Components: European Youth Forum, National Youth Council (Go-For), Izmir Metropolitan Municipality, Izmir City Council Youth Council

Every session was 20 minutes long and every table had its own report writer from employees of Izmir Metropolitan Municipality and European Youth Capital Application Secreteriat again.

In this section, participants produced sollutions to problems that they already determined. Instead of visiting every table, participants had a chance to pick the table what they desire to discuss about. Participation on administrative, social and cultural (education), economical, environmental and ecological, and freedom were the titles of the tables.

Participants including representatives from the City Council, local governments, student groups, NGOs and activists, came together and they created a communication cycle in the meeting directed by the idea of common mind. During the event, different techniques were used and small groups continued discussions. All participants could find a place to express their opinions, and contribute youth culture of the city. On thr other hand, the contributions of European Youth Capital on youth works and policies in the city was mentioned.

After the agreement on the idea of running the process together, the voluntery working team for 2026 European Youth Capital was determined, and runing the process with different activities with this team was decided at the end of the meeting.

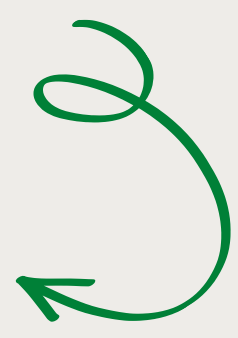
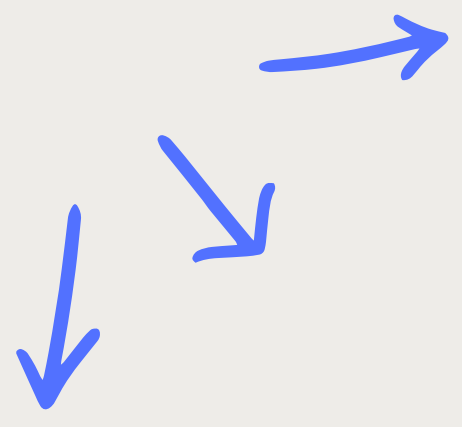

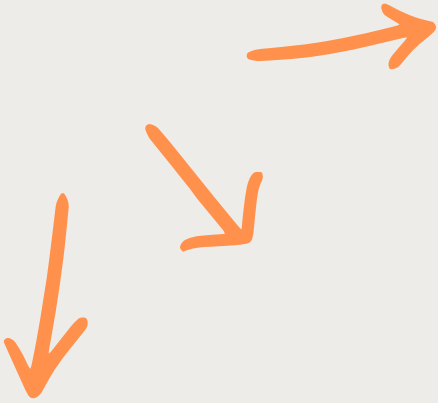
